



# Collection Development at the ASCL Library

## Availability of English and French African Studies resources based on scholarly citations (2010–2015)



## Linguistic changes in the collection 2010–2022

As of 2021 the ASCL library also collects titles in African languages, see for example the Somali (411 monographs) and Kinyarwanda (302 monographs) collection. For the next few years the library will significantly expand the Swahili language collection (now 1422 monographs).
